- are words that join words, phrases and clauses in a sentence

Coordinating Conjunctions

- Use a coordinating conjunction when you want to give equal emphasis to two main clauses.

for	and	nor
but	or	yet
so		



Coordinating Conjunctions

Ex.

We listened to the song eagerly, for it teaches the lesson on conjunctions.



Subordinating Conjunctions

- links a dependent clause to an independent clause

although	as
after	before
because	



Subordinating Conjunctions

Ex.

Whenever we hear this song, we have to sing along.



Correlative Conjunctions

- conjunctions that are used in pairs
- links words used the same way

both... and	either... or
neither... nor	both... and
so... as	not only... but also



Subordinating Conjunctions

Ex.

The song is **both** entertaining
and informative.
